Quick & easy mucking out

The Quick.Gate allows for the simultaneous mucking out of several outdoor runs in the shortest possible time. Due to special hinges, it lifts itself out of the straw onto the lateral concrete edge when opened. Due to a 2nd slide edge on the other side of the run, a long trough is formed alongside the house. Muck can be pushed out with a tractor in a single go in the shortest time possible.

The Quick.Gate is a gate that lifts out of the straw by itself when opened. The hinged side of the Quick.Gate is attached to the house and can be swung open to either side. In the process, it lifts itself out of the straw onto the lateral concrete edge due to the special hinges.

Other solutions with holding wire only lift out to one side, can be lifted out by the sows on their own or you cannot install the wire rope as you would like - for example if there is a window or an open wall with wind mesh. In addition, the Quick.Gate closes the house openings for the animals when it is opened, and a long corridor is formed. Now, the farmer can push the manure out with a tractor or wheel loader from one end to the other of the outdoor run and in this way muck out many runs in the shortest possible time.

Self-lifting to both sides

In the concept of many organic farms, individual pens are provided, especially when farrowing, and their outdoor runs are lined with straw. This means extra work for the farmer – after all, regular mucking out of the houses is necessary in order to reduce odour levels.

The hinged side of the Quick.Gate is attached to the house and can be swung open to either side. Due to the special hinges, it lifts itself out of the straw onto the lateral concrete edge. This means that it can be opened quickly and easily without pushing manure in front of it.

Furthermore, the Quick.Gate closes the openings of the animals' house when it is opened, forming a long corridor along the entire house. The farmer can now push out the manure with a tractor "in one go" from one end of the runs to the other. This means that, depending on the size of the facility, 20 outdoor outlets can be mucked out in ten minutes, for example. Saving the farmer a lot of time in his daily work.
